He has held numerous principal positions in various orchestras, including the New York All-State Symphony, NSO Summer Music Institute, and in the Empire State Youth Orchestra for 3 years. Summers have been spent at the NSO Summer Music Institute, Center Stage Strings, and the Taipei Music Academy & Festival.
